This release of IBM Aspera Connect 4.1 provides the new features, fixes, and other changes listed below.

NEW FEATURES

When connecting to Faspex 5 BETA, Connect uses your default browser for OAuth 2 authorization to Faspex 5 BETA resources. (Aspera/connect-app#713)

Connect supports the Faspex 5 BETA. Send and download packages and browse nodes using Connect. (Aspera/connect-app#168)

DOCUMENTATION UPDATES

Aspera/connect-app.docs#20 - Upgraded the importance of a note that warns customers not to enable debug or trace logging unless needed due to impact on performance.

ISSUES FIXED IN THIS RELEASE

Aspera/connect-app#660 - [macOS] Visual glitch appears on Accounts page when starting transfers with a new server.

Aspera/connect-app#771 - [Windows] Download silently continues even after user presses stop button during "Connecting" phase.

Aspera/connect-app#669 - [Linux] Unable to launch asperaconnect on some Linux machines with the error "Could not load the Qt platform plugin 'xcb'".

Aspera/connect-sdk#69 - Removed the word "dummy" in codebase to align with inclusivity guidelines.

Aspera/connect-app#605 - Drive (now Connect) intermittently crashes during AoC sync.

Server Requirements

One of the following:

- IBM Aspera Shares a currently supported version
- IBM Aspera Faspex a currently supported version
- IBM Aspera High-Speed Transfer Server (HSTS) 3.9.6 or higher recommended

To use Connect's Aspera Drive feature with any of the above servers, the server must have a Drive-enabled or Cargo-enabled license.

To use Connect's Aspera Drive synchronization features, the server must have a Sync-enabled license.

The minimum version of Connect that works with the Connect SDK is now 3.9.0.

KNOWN ISSUES

Aspera/connect-app#901 - [macOS] The current one-click installer does not support a system-wide install on macOS. **Workaround:** To do a system-wide install on macOS with the current one-click installer:

- 1. Log in as an Administrator of the machine.
- 2. Open the binary distribution file (.dmg file) to mount the installer
- 3. Run:

 $\verb|sudo|/Volumes/ibm-aspera-connect_4.1xx_macOS_x86_64/IBM \land Aspera \land Connect \land Installer.app/Contents/Resources/install true|$

Aspera/connect-app#811 - Windows Explorer crashes in some situations trying to view package files in Faspex 5 BETA.

Note: This issue will be resolved in future updates to Faspex 5 BETA.
