# Chapter 1. Release notes for version 2.0.4

These release notes apply to version 2.0.4 of IBM Spectrum Discover.

#### New features in this release

#### Known issues in version 2.0.4

The following known issues exist in version 2.0.4 of IBM Spectrum Discover, with workarounds included wherever possible. If you come across an issue that cannot be solved using these instructions, contact IBM Support.

#### COS connection reporting scan aborted due to inactivity

If a COS connection scan fails with the error "Scan aborted because of a long period of inactivity" this can be resolved by editing the settings file /opt/ibm/metaocean/data/connections/cos/scan/scanner-settings.json and choosing a higher value for notifier\_timeout than the default value of 120 seconds. The change will be picked up on the next scan, no pod restart is required.

Within an OpenShift deployment, the settings file is connections/cos/scan/scanner-settings.json within the data PV.

## Group by filename error after a SQL query

When using the Query builder, an error will occur if 'filename' is selected from the 'Group by' list. If information regarding potential duplicate files/objects is desired, then this can be displayed by clicking one of the links in the 'Duplicate file information' section of the dashboard.

#### Ingestion issue on new connection after upgrade

If a new connection is quickly created right after an upgrade then the producers may not receive the connection\_updates connection notice in time and run with an outdated connection list. This means you will not be able to ingest on your new connection.

To resolve this simply select the connection in the UI to edit it and save it and this will refresh the connections notices to producers and you can then ingest on this connection.

## Mixed text/binary files not recognised by content search

If a file passed to Contentsearch is not internally recognised as text it is passed to Apache Tika. In the case of a file with embedded binary control characters, the version of Tika supplied rejects them as an

unrecognized media format. As a workaround, the file extension can be added to the Contentsearch config text\_filetypes field.

#### No notification displayed when data export initiated

Status for data export actions can be viewed from the bell icon notification center.

#### OpenShift: Database connection issue after reboot

If an unexpected cluster update or node reboot causes database connection issues it may be necessary to check the following:

- All storage is mounted correctly on the compute nodes for system data and remount/reconnect if necessary
- System is connected to database and normal system operations such as create connection, scan, view connections, policies are working
- If above operations cannot be carried out check the state of the db2whrest pod and restart pod to reestablish database connection if necessary by deleting the pod:

```
oc delete pod -l app=spectrum-discover-db2whrest
```

#### OpenShift: Image pull error due to authentication failure

The OCP login token expires occasionally, and as this is the container image registry password this breaks the service account access to the registry.

If a pod is failing to pull an image from the registry with an authentication error, then recreate the image-registry-pull-secret and re-link the service accounts to the new secret:

The above updates the password for the external image registry URL - if instead the internal URL was used in the custom resources, then the HOST variable should be pointed at that URL before recreating the secret.

#### **OpenShift: Metadata summarization database not refreshing**

After a communication error with Db2u, the Metadata summarization database may stop refreshing. Under normal conditions, the Metadata summarization database updates every 30 minutes. If the 'Last updated:' timestamp on the dashboard doesn't update after several hours, it may be necessary to recover.

To identify if this problem has been encountered, check the db2wh-rest logs:

```
oc logs -l app=spectrum-discover-db2whrest -c spectrum-discover
```

If there is an error message similar to this:

2020-12-06 09:00:07,164 - sumtab - ERROR - SummaryTableUpdater hit execption ('40003', '\[40003] \[IBM]\[CLI Driver] SQL30081N A communication error has been detected. Communication protocol being used: "TCP/IP". Communication API being used: "SOCKETS". Location where the error was detected: "172.30.197.250". Communication function detecting

the error: "recv". Protocol specific error code(s): "", "", "0". SQLSTATE= $08001\n$  (-30081) (SQLExecDirectW)')

Then the db2wh-rest pod must be restarted to recover. To restart the pod run:

oc delete pod -1 app=spectrum-discover-db2whrest

#### OVA: Spectrum Discover login failing right after install

The installation script ("launch\_ansible") may finish before all the Spectrum Discover pods are fully running; it can take up to 10 minutes from successful installation until logins work through the UI.

#### Previously scanned metadata missing some unicode characters

Prior to release 2.0.4, scans of IBM COS or S3 data sources did not correctly capture object names with some unicode characters (including Chinese characters). After upgrading Spectrum Discover to 2.0.4, a rescan of the data source will properly capture the unicode characters in the Spectrum Discover catalog.

#### **UI issues in ESR versions of Firefox**

Older versions of the Firefox ESR browser may experience alignment issues with the UI. A workaround is to use a more recent version of Firefox or Google Chrome.

# Visual query builder search terms overrides SQL search when going into individual mode

If a search is started in the query builder then changed to SQL mode, the initial group search is as expected but if expanded to individual records it uses the query builder terms as the base.

A workaround is to clear the visual query before changing to SQL query.
