# Release note

This release notes is for IBM System Storage with ProtecTIER Software.

Release date: March 09, 2020

## Introduction

This Security Patch addresses the following bugs in RedHat 5.11, it will have no effect over the ProtecTIER application functionality.

CVE-2019-14287

All ProtecTIER installs using version V3.4.x.x are eligible to install this fix.

Customers running 2-node cluster configuration, require installing the security <u>patch on each node separately.</u>

## **Prerequisites**

This fix is only supported on PTV3.4.x.x.

Customers running lower versions need to upgrade to the latest code to install the security patch.

### <u>V3.4.x</u>

Copy package "PT\_MD5\_Sudo\_Upgrade\_V3.4.99.sudobypass.x86\_64.tar" to "/install/new/"



## Installation

### For V3.4.x.x

- 1. Copy package to /install/new/ directory.
- 2. Use the following command to open the RAS menu:

# menu

- 3. Select "ProtecTIER Configuration (...)" by typing the corresponding number and pressing <Enter>.
- 4. Select "Single Node code upgrade (For Support Use ONLY)" by typing the corresponding number and pressing <Enter>.
- 5. Type y to install PT\_MD5\_Sudo\_Upgrade\_V3.4.99.sudobypass.x86\_64.tar
- 6. Reboot the server to activate the vulnerability fix.

Note: The vulnerability fix can only be deployed by use of the "Single Node - code upgrade... " from the RAS menu.
