Symptom: The documentation reference of ITIM 5.1 contains the documentation of account restore properties. Here the property "account.restore.password.suppress" is wrongly documented.

Note: In ITIM 5.1 "account.restore.password.suppress" property is no longer considered while restoring an account. In ITIM 5.1 the password is always suppressed while restoring the account unless this is required. It was decided that this property is no longer relevant with the new UI design and the password is only changed for the accounts that require a new password.

During an account restore, the password is changed for only those accounts which require a new password, which can be set on the service profile level through the following profile property:

```
com.ibm.itim.remoteservices.ResourceProperties.  
PASSWORD_NOT_REQUIRED_ON_RESTORE=false.
```

For ITIM Service, the following property has been introduced in \$ITIM_HOME/data/enRole.properties file to specify whether password is required for ITIM Account on restore. If this property is not there then the default value is taken as false.

```
password.required.itimaccount.restore=true
```

Behavior if password synchronization is enabled

If ITIM password synchronization is enabled and there is an ersynchpassword attribute on in the requestee's person object, ITIM will use ersynchpassword for any accounts which require a password on restore. If ersynchpassword is not present on the requestee's person object, ITIM will prompt for a password as needed and will save that password as the new ersynchpassword.

For the condition where there is a password history rule which disallows re-use of the previous password, a new property has been introduced in \$ITIM_HOME/data/enRole.properties file to override password validation on account restore (set to false by default)

```
account.restore.skip.password.validation=false
```

Behavior if password synchronization is not enabled

If ITIM password synchronization is not enabled, ITIM will prompt for a password for accounts that require a password change on restore.

These rules also govern behavior during a person restore with accounts.
